For all eternity.

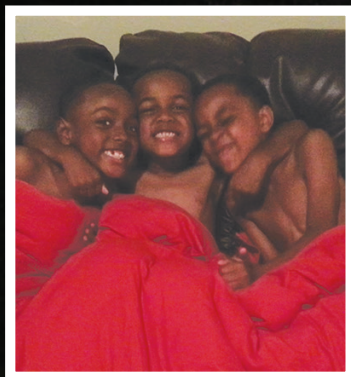
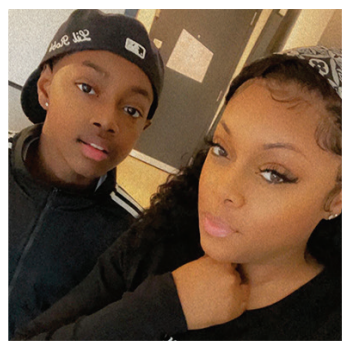
